- New self-flushing toilets and commercial grade fixtures
- Replacing approximately half the roof
- Painting the inside and power washing the outside of the building
- Deep cleaning and sanitizing the building: carpets, chairs, tables, kitchen, and leather on couches.

There are many characteristics of our building that make social distancing difficult. These include the design of the entrance, kitchen and restrooms. As a result, we continue to monitor the regulatory environment in which we find ourselves.
